

Student Code of Conduct on Campus Academic Year 2018-2019

1. Treat teachers, staff, classmates and their property with respect at all times. Practice the "Golden Rule" - "Do unto others as you would have done unto you." Do not touch anyone.
2. Do not damage school or personal property including your office/desk space.
3. Never leave campus, for any reason, without first obtaining permission from the school office.
4. Obey all individual class rules; maintaining an attitude of honesty and integrity at all times. Cheating/plagiarism is never an option. (See handbook for definition)
5. Maintain an attitude of reverence during morning devotions, prayer, Bible class and chapel.
6. Do not run anywhere on campus with the exception of recess and P.E. class.
7. Guard the purity of the opposite sex in all areas of speech and conduct at all times.
8. Profanity is not tolerated.
9. Cell phones and electronic devices are not to be used during school hours. Cell phones and electronic devices must be turned in at the beginning of the school day to the teacher and retrieved at the end. The use of cell phones or other electronic devices to take pictures or videos is prohibited.
10. Regular attendance and punctuality are essential to student success. Students with more than five unexcused absences per quarter may be subject to disciplinary action up to and including suspension and expulsion. **Excessive absences, tardies, or early withdrawal from school, excused or not, will affect your child's academic grades. CLASSWORK MISSED DUE TO UNEXCUSED ABSENCES, TARDIES OR EARLY WITHDRAWAL FROM SCHOOL WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO BE MADE UP.**
